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Data listings

Introduction

The following tables (**Table A1.1** to **A6.1**) include the data for topics mapped in the second edition of *A Social Health Atlas of Australia*.

The value calculated for each area mapped has been assigned a ranking, based on the percentage value, rate or standardised ratio for the variable. A rank of ‘1’ indicates the area has the highest percentage, rate or standardised ratio (ie. its population has the highest level of disadvantage, the poorest health status or the highest rate of health service utilisation). Separate rankings have been assigned for the areas in the capital cities, other major urban centres and non-metropolitan areas.

Where totals are not equal to the sum of the component figures, the discrepancy exists because the totals either cover areas which were excluded from the analysis (ie. areas with small numbers of cases), or include residents outside of Australia or particular

States; and/or because the component figures have been rounded.

The data can also be accessed electronically from a CD-ROM (for Windows). These data are in spreadsheet files in Microsoft Excel 97 format and include all of the data mapped in the atlas (order from AusInfo, or see details on PHIDU the World Wide Web site: www.publichealth.gov.au) Some data are also available in the HealthWIZ database (see www.prometheus.com.au)

The following tables provide brief notes on the data mapped. More complete details are generally provided in the atlas.

¹When interpreting the figures for low income families in the text in this chapter, it should be noted that the indicators of low income used in the comparisons (\$12,000 per annum or less in 1986 and less than \$21,000 per annum in 1996) do not equate to equivalent incomes and have thus not been adjusted based on changes to buying power. Rather, they are based on categories of income available from the Census and denote comparability of income in 1986, 1991 and 1996 based on the levels of incomes of recipients of the sole parents’ allowance and unemployment allowances.

²These variables were not mapped but are included in the correlation analyses.

³This variable was adjusted using age-sex standardisation: a description of this process is in the text above.

The pensions and benefits are listed in **Table 2**, which also shows the way in which the DFACS and DVA data were combined for mapping. Percentages were calculated on population figures representing as near as possible the ages applicable to the particular pensioner and beneficiary groups.

All health status and health service utilisation variables (with the exception of the variables for the Physical Component Summary, infant deaths, the Total Fertility Rate and immunisation status are age-adjusted and represented by standardised ratios.

- The Physical Component Summary is expressed as a mean score, with higher scores indicating better physical health.
- The infant death rate is calculated as the number of infant deaths (deaths under one year of age) per 1,000 live births.
- The Total Fertility Rate is a measure of the number of children a woman can expect to bear in her lifetime: it was derived by indirect age standardisation, based on Australian totals.
- Immunisation status is expressed as a percentage of children who were fully immunised at 12 months of age.

The number of beds in public acute hospitals (average available beds over 1995/1996) and private hospitals (available beds at 30 June 1997) have been mapped per 1,000 population of the area in which the hospital is located. Nursing home places and hostel places are mapped per 1,000 population aged 70 years and over of the area in which the facility is located.

The social health status’ clusters were produced by a joint analysis of the socioeconomic status and health status variables.
